Reply filed on behalf of the respondent in Court today is taken on record.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Ludhiana to Jalandhar.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 as also complaint under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. at Jalandhar. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 70 kilometers from Jalandhar to Ludhiana on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as

also the circumstances explained by them particularly when there is no serious objection by counsel for the respondent, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Ludhiana is transferred to Jalandhar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
