

RA-CW-223-2015 & CM No.6410 of 2015 in CWP No.6244 of 2009

Ajeet Kumar Dawar vs. State of Haryana and others

The review application has been filed through different counsel. Under the garb of review, an effort has been made to re-argue the case which is not permissible. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Tamil Nadu Electricity Board and another vs. N.Raju Reddiar and another***, (1997) 9 SCC 736, has deprecated the filing of review petitions by changing the counsel who had originally not filed the petition. It was observed thus:-

“Once the petition for review is dismissed, no application for clarification should be filed, much less with the change of the advocate-on-record. This practice of changing the advocates and filing repeated petitions should be deprecated with heavy hand for purity of administration of law and salutary and healthy practice.”

In view of the above, no ground is made out for entertaining the review application. Dismissed. As a result, even CM No.6410 of 2015 seeking permission of this court for determining the authority of the previous advocate, is dismissed.
