Review of the judgment of this Court dated 30.9.2013 has been sought on the short point namely that while assessing the compensation, reliance was placed upon an earlier judgment of this Court in RFA No. 1364 of 1994 Dharamsala Pukhta vs The Punjab State decided on 4.9.2012, vide which the compensation for the land acquired in the vicinity at the same time was determined. The ground on which the review has been sought is that the the aforesaid judgment was reviewed by this Court vide order dated 27.2.2015 passed in RA No. 99/CI of 2014 in RFA No. 4241 of 2006 Vijay and another vs State of Punjab and others and the amount of compensation was finally determined at ₹ 110/- per square yard as against ₹ 265/- per square yard determined earlier.

Learned counsel for the non-applicant/ landowners did not dispute the aforesaid factual position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the appeal was disposed of while awarding compensation to the landowners in terms of judgment of this Court in Dharamsala Pukhta's case (supra), which has to be reviewed on 27.2.2015, the order passed by

this Court in the present appeal on 30.9.2013 is reviewed. The compensation in the appeal in question is also determined at ₹ 110/- per square yard besides statutory benefits.

The review application stands disposed of.
