Vide order dated 12.12.2014, District Magistrate, Panipat was directed to inquire into the averments made by the petitioner in the present writ petition in the context of illegal confinement of respondents No.5 to 7.

In pursuance of the aforesaid order, District Magistrate, Panipat/respondent No.2 has submitted the fact finding inquiry report endorsing that Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Panipat was assigned to conduct the necessary inquiry into the matter. Sub Divisional Magistrate, Panipat inspected the spot and recorded the statements of some labourours found at the spot and on the basis of spot inspection and inquiry, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Panipat submitted his report to the District Magistrate.

As per aforesaid fact finding inquiry report, the petitioner Ram Kumar never came to M/s Ganesh Brick-kiln Company, Village Buana Lakhu, Israna, District Panipat.

Statements of some other labourours namely Rakesh and Chand were also recorded to the effect that Ram Kumar never ever worked in the brick-kiln in question nor is presently working.

Ultimately, the aforesaid inquiry report reveals that the present case is not of bonded labour as has been projected by the petitioner. Therefore, no further action is required to be taken.

Thus, the petition is dismissed as having been infructuous.
