Short affidavit of Sh. Yadvendra Singh son of Sh. R.N Singh, DIG, SHQ BSF, Udaipur has been filed today in the Court and the same is taken on record. It has been stated in the affidavit that necessary approval from the Ministry of Home Affairs has been obtained for grant of invalid pension to the petitioner, subject to the final outcome of LPA No. 328/2015.

Learned counsel for the respondents has also placed on record copy of a cheque amounting to Rs. 2,07,440/- (Rupees two lacs seven thousand four hundred and forty only) towards arrears of pension, which has been placed on record as mark 'A'. The original cheque has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner, which is the amount of pension arrears for the period of three years, as per order passed in LPA No.328-2015.

In view of the aforesaid, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that no further action is required in this execution application.
