Affidavit dated 04.12.2015 of Commission of Police, Amritsar along with Annexures R-1 & R-2, filed in the Court today, is taken on record and copy thereof has been supplied to Mr. K.D.S. Sodhi, Advocate learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Randhir Singh, Police Station E-Division, Amritsar, refers to the orders dated 04.11.2015 (Annexure R-1) and the status report dated 01.12.2015 (Annexure R-2), to contend that since the SIT has already been constituted in compliance of the orders dated 19.10.2015 passed by this Court and the matter is being enquired into by the SIT, the matter may be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

In view of the abovesaid statement made by learned counsel for the State, no further orders are called for, at the hands of this Court. It goes

without saying that SIT will enquire into the matter effectively and shall conclude it at an early date. Thereafter, appropriate action shall be taken by the competent authority, in accordance with law.
