On 4.5.2015, the petition was admitted and the factum of admission was ordered to be published in the newspapers namely 'The Indian Express' (English) and 'Jansatta' (Hindi) and in the official Gazette of Government of Haryana. Affidavit of publication has been filed. Even learned counsel for the respondent has no objection for directing winding up of the respondent company.

According, the respondent company is directed to be wound up.

The Official Liquidator is appointed as Liquidator of the respondent company. He is directed to take over the moveable and immovable assets and records of the respondent company.

At the time of hearing, it was pointed out that the respondent company is to receive certain amount from the Department of Telecommunication, Government of India. There is an order passed by the Debts Recovery Tribunal-II, Delhi in OA No.388 of 2014 IDBI Bank Ltd. vs M/s S. Tel Pvt. Ltd. and others on 18.8.2015, restraining the Department of Telecommunication, Ministry of Communication & IT, New Delhi, from disbursing a sum of ₹ 35,33,38,634/- or any other amounts found due to respondent company, until further orders of the Tribunal.

The aforesaid amount lying with the Department of Telecommunication or any other amount due to the respondent company, is directed to be remitted to the Official Liquidator attached to this Court.

Let notice of winding up be published in the newspapers, namely, “Indian Express” (English) and “Jansatta” (Hindi), and the official Gazette of Government of Haryana.

The order shall be communicated by the Official Liquidator to the concerned office in the Department of Telecommunication, Ministry of Communication & IT, New Delhi.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
