Vide order dated 13th February, 2001 Letters of Administration with copy of the Will annexed to the petition was granted in favour of the petitioner with regard to properties mentioned in the list (Ex. No. 1921/2003 in view of the settlement arrived at between him and the petitioner. Application is allowed and I.A. No. 1921/2003 is disposed of as withdrawn.
