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ORDER

Present writ petitions have been filed seeking benefits of 2nd Assured Career Progression (ACP) Scheme on completion of 24 years of service.

Learned counsel for the respondents state that payments in accordance with the Division Bench's judgments have been paid.

However, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the leave encashment component has not been paid.

Upon a perusal of the Division Bench's orders, this Court finds that leave encashment component has not been specifically mentioned. However, as learned counsel for petitioners states that the same is a part of the 2nd ACP benefits, petitioners are directed to file an application with the respondents seeking reimbursement of the leave encashment component in terms of the second financial upgradation. Upon such an application being filed, respondents are directed to dispose of the same within four weeks.

With the aforesaid directions, present contempt petitions stand dispose of.
