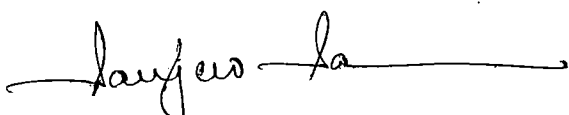

On 11.2.2015, we had passed an interim order directing the respondents not to reject the petitioner's bid on the ground that a scanned copy of the Bank Guarantee was submitted and we had also directed that the original Bank Guarantee shall be furnished by the petitioner within 48 hours.

Both these directions have been complied with. In fact, the petitioner was permitted to participate in the auction and his bid was not treated as non-responsive on this ground. However, the petitioner could not succeed because he did not fall within the 50% criterion in terms of Clause 3.3.2 of the tender documents. As such, these writ petitions have become infructuous.

The writ petitions are disposed of as having become infructuous.
