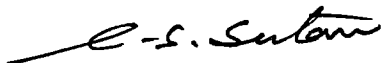

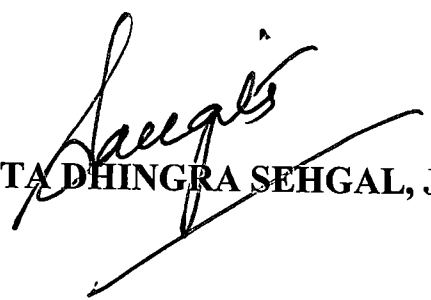
of India and Union Public Service Commission is practically the same.
