1. It is brought to the notice of this Court by the appellant that applications under Section 254 (2) are pending before the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal (ITAT) in respect of certain alterations as certain arguments could not be considered at the time of disposal of the appeals which are subject matters of the Tribunal proceedings.
