6. Needless to state that if the decision is taken in favour of the petitioner, the lookout notice and the entry made on the Passport shall be deleted within one week thereafter.

7. If the petitioner is still aggrieved with the decision of the respondents, he may approach the appropriate forum.

8. In view of the above terms, present petition stands disposed of.
