Parties have settled their disputes before the Delhi High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre on 2nd March, 2015 on the terms and conditions as stipulated in the Settlement Agreement, which is marked as Mark 'C-1'. Settlement Agreement has been signed by the parties and their respective counsel. Parties shall remain bound by the terms of Mark 'C-1'. Learned counsel for the plaintiff submits that plaintiff has completed his part of obligation as contained in Mark 'C-1'. Learned counsel for the defendant submits that defendant will complete his part of obligation within 6 weeks.
