The petitioner seeks extension of parole which has been granted to him by the order dated 08.06.2015 for a period of 30 days. It has been submitted that the period of parole expires tomorrow i.e. 10.07.2015. It is further submitted that during the period that the petitioner was on parole, he suffered injuries in his knees and the Doctors have advised him rest for 2 weeks as he is suffering from degenerative arthritis and has been suggested for the knee brace.

Considering the above facts, this Court is inclined to extend the parole period for a further period till 15.7.2015.

The petitioner would positively surrender before the jail authorities on or before 15.07.2015.

Let it be noted that no further extension of parole would be granted on such ground. The extension of parole would be subject to the earlier conditions imposed upon him vide order dated 08.06.2015.

The application is disposed of accordingly.
