All the petitioners seek directions that second financial

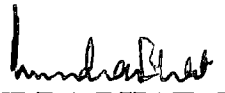
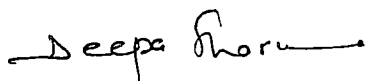
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upgradation/Assured Career Progression ("ACP") Scheme dated 09.08.1999 should be granted to them.
