ORAL ORDER

In compliance with the directions given by order, dated 23.09.2016, respondent No.4, namely, Senior Superintendent of Police, Muzaffarpur, respondent No.7, namely, Officer-In-Charge, Saraiya Police Station, Muzaffarpur, and



respondent No.8, namely, Sanjay Pathak, the Investigating Officer, presently posted as S.H.O., Jaitpur (O.P.) Saraiya Police Station, District Muzaffarpur, have appeared, in person, and filed affidavit showing cause and also a supplementary counter affidavit.
