16 19-01-2016 Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant submitted that in fact while disposing of this First Appeal by the order dated 21.04.2010 by mistake cross objection was not disposed of which was filed by the respondent.

In view of the submissions, perused the order dated 21.04.2010. Admittedly the cross objection was filed prior to the said order dated 21.04.2010 by the cross objector-respondent.
