Petitioners seek bail in a case registered under
Sections-272 & 273 of the Indian Penal Code and 47 of Bihar
Excise Amendment, Act 2016.

Twenty litres of Mahua liquor is said to have been
recovered from joint possession of the petitioners, for which, the
petitioners are languishing in jail custody since 14-07-2016.
Petitioners do not have any criminal antecedent and claim of the
petitioners is that they have falsely been implicated in this case by
the police.

Considering the above-said facts and circumstances
of the case as well as submission of the parties, let the petitioners
