Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection with Kasim Bazar P.S. Case No. 144 of 2015 registered under Sections 365 and 366-A read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It has been contended that the petitioner has been implicated in the present case simply because he happens to be the father of co-accused Mukesh Mandal. On recovery, the victim has made certain allegations against Mukesh Mandal, but she has not uttered a word against the petitioner.

Regard being had to the statement of the victim

recorded under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as contained in Annexure-2 to the present application, in the event of arrest or surrender in the court below within six weeks from today, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Munger in connection with Kasim Bazar P.S. Case No. 144 of 2015 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
