report on the basis of the information given by witnesses Ashok

Paswan and Chandradeo Paswan who claimed that they had seen

the petitioners fleeing from the field of sugar cane from where the

dead body of the deceased was recovered and except the aforesaid

material, there appears to be nothing against the petitioners.

Previous enmity between the petitioners and the informant is
