3 11-05-2016 Petitioner has remained in custody since 26.07.2014.

Since the trial has not proceeded as is the statement of the counsel representing the petitioner, taking into consideration the period spent by the petitioner in custody, let the petitioner above named be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each, one of the surety will be executed by Smt. Nisha Devi who is said to be the wife of the petitioner whose identity will be well verified by the court below ensuring that no imposter claims herself to be Nisha Devi and the other surety will be executed by a close blood relation of the petitioner, to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-IV, Bard in connection with Barh P.S. Case No.254 of 2014, giving rise to Sessions Trial No.242 of 2015.

The petitioner will appear on each and every date since the trial is still on unless exempted by the court below. He shall also neither intimidate the witnesses or the victim nor in any manner sabotage the smooth conduct of the trial. He shall also desist from committing any further crime while enjoying the privilege of bail. Any failure, as above, may allow the prosecution to seek cancellation of his bail.
