3      15-03-2016                      Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned  
counsel representing the State.

Petitioners seek bail in connection with Amba P.S. Case  
No. 80 of 2015 registered for the offences punishable under  
Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, the petitioners being armed with lathi-danda  
came at the house of the informant and claimed that the wife of the  
informant is Dain. Further they started assaulting the wife of the  
informant and after dragging her from the house brutally assaulted  
and killed her.

Submission is of false implication due to previous dispute,  
the doctor who has conducted post mortem examination has found  
only two external injuries on the person of the deceased, there is

general and omnibus allegation and as such the petitioners who are suffering in custody since 05.10.2015 deserve sympathetic consideration to which learned APP seriously opposes by submitting that during investigation the witnesses have supported the prosecution version.

In the facts and circumstances stated above, considering the allegation attributed against the petitioners serious in nature, this Court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail, accordingly, their such prayer stands rejected.

However, considering the period of detention, the trial court is directed to expedite the trial.
