2 10-02-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 12.10.2015 in connection
with a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections
25(1-B)A,26, 35 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though there
is allegation of recovery of arms from the person of the petitioner
yet, in fact, there was no such recovery and seizure-list itself
indicate that there was no independent witness to support the
prosecution case. He submits that since he has opposed the
collection of illegal money by the Police personal from the sand
loaded trucks, the petitioner has been roped into the present case.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances

and that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad in connection with Barun P.S. Case No. 147/2015.
