Petitioner is named in the first information report but
the informant himself has admitted in his written report that when
he went in search of her daughter-in-law petitioner met him on
Barauni railway station and disclosed the name of co-accused Md.
Akram, who abducted the informant's daughter-in-law.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as
well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioner, above named,
be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with
two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief
Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai in connection with Barauni
