3 08-04-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Addl. Public Prosecutor.

The petitioner, who is in custody since 26.12.2015 in
Rajpur P.S. Case no.238 of 2015 registered for the offence under
Section 25(1-b) A, 26 of the Indian Penal Code, has prayed for
grant of bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has falsely been implicated showing recovery of one
country-made pistol with two live cartridges. It has been argued
that the petitioner is having clean antecedent. This fact has been
mentioned in paragraph-3 of the petition.

Keeping in view the nature of accusation, period of
custody as well as clean antecedent of the petitioner, let the

petitioner, namely, Dhananjay Pandey be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Ravindra Kumar Rai, learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate-7, Buxar in connection with Rajpur P.S. Case no.238 of 2015.
