Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since
29.12.2015 in a case registered for the offences punishable under
sections 20, 22 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

The prosecution case is that from a hutment, from
where the petitioner fled away, 350 grams of Ganja kept in a bag
were recovered.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that
there is nothing on record to suggest that the hutment belongs to
the petitioner. Statement has been in paragraph 3 of the petition
that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned counsel for the State has not controverted this
fact that quantity of recovered contraband is 350 grams only.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, N.D.P.S., Nawada in connection with Nawada Town P.S. Case No. 662 of 2014.
