Looking at the nature of the relief, prayed for by the petitioner and not unmindful of the notification contained in Annexure-1, the only way the petitioner can dislodge the Managing Committee and the persons at the helms of affairs and claim any status is by obtaining a declaration may be from a civil court of competent jurisdiction where the authenticity, honesty and the correctness of the petitioner to claim such relief can be established after close scrutiny and evidence. Writ Court is not the forum for such adjudication especially when fraud, deceit and various other things are



pleaded against the notification issued by the State contained in
Annexure-1.

Writ is dismissed.
