2 15-03-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as

learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioners seek bail in a case registered under Section
304 (B) of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioners happen to be elders brother-in-law of the
deceased and are languishing in jail custody since 21.11.2015 and
23.11.2015 respectively.

It is pointed out on behalf of the petitioners that
husband as well as father-in-law of the deceased have already been
acquitted by the trial court after full-fledged trial and, therefore,
the detention of petitioners in jail custody is meaningless.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as

well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioners above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional District and Sessions Judge-III, Lakhisarai, District Lakhisarai in connection with Halsi P.S. Case No.102 of 2010.
