It would appear from perusal of the impugned order that except confessional statement of petitioner and suspicion raised by witnesses in course of investigation against the petitioner, there is no other cogent evidence to show the involvement of the petitioner in the alleged crime. Moreover, having more or less similar allegation, co-accused Chandrika Manjhi has already been granted privilege of bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief
