Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under

Sections-302, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner happens to be father-in-law of the deceased

and the informant claims in her fardbyan that it was husband of

the deceased, who used to assault the deceased and, committed her

murder. So far as petitioner is concerned; it is only stated that he

along with others, helped husband of the deceased in disposing of

dead body of the deceased.
