One iron made weapon and one mobile are said to

have been recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner,

when the petitioner, allegedly, along with others had assembled to

make preparation for committing dacoity and for the aforesaid act,

the petitioner is languishing in jail custody since 30-01-2016.

Moreover, the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent,

which is evident from perusal of paragraph-3 of the petition.

directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.

10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each
