2 13-05-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
Addl. Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of the State.

This application for grant of anticipatory bail arises out
of Buxar (Town) P.S.Case No. 52/2016, disclosing offences under
sections 218, 420, 349 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner was posted as Halka Karamchari in Buxar
Block. It is alleged that he, in connivance with the Circle Officer
issued land possession certificate showing incorrect share of the
informant. It is informant's case that he held only 1/4th share of
the joint family property, whereas land possession certificate was
issued showing whole property in his name. Because of issuance
of such certificate, he was denied loan exemption by the Bank

Learned counsel, appearing on behalf of the petitioner, has
submitted that no offence under section 420 of the I.P.C. is made

out on the basis of what has been alleged in the F.I.R. It has also been submitted that the correct land possession certificate was issued showing the informant to be holding 1/4th share in the property.

Considering the nature of allegation, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, abovenamed, in the event of his arrest/ surrender before the court below within six weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Buxar in Buxar (Town) P.S.Case No. 52/2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioner shall present himself before the police/ court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on his part to appear before the court on two consecutive occasions, his bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
