3 30-05-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

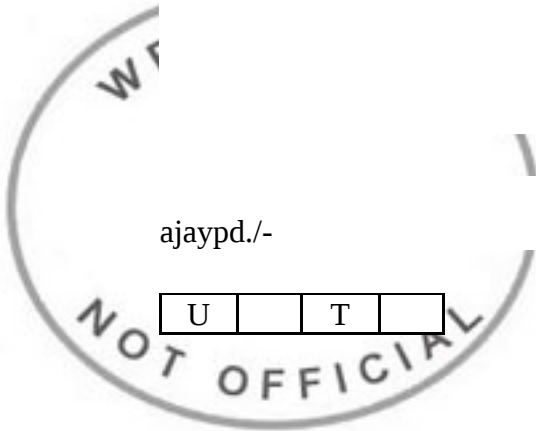
learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.
