Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is accused in connection with
Pakribarawan P.S. Case No. 84 of 2013, registered under Section
395 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. In course of investigation
the name of the petitioner was surfaced in the confessional
statement of co-accused Pawan Kumar @ Kailu, except the
confessional statement there is nothing against the petitioner to
show his involvement in the present case. Further submission is
that petitioner is accused in five other cases, as detailed in para 3
of the petition, but in all cases he is on bail. The petitioner is in
custody since 29.01.2016.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nawada in connection with Pakribarawan P.S. Case No. 84 of 2013.
