2 02-06-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 18.01.2016 in connection with Goh P.S. Case No. 176 of 2015 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 461 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code. Later on Sections 295, 411, 414, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 25 Antiques & Treasure Act and Section 30(i)(iii) Ancient Monument and Archeological Sites & Remains Act was added.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been taken into custody on the basis of suspicion and there has been no recovery of stolen articles from the possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that other similarly co-accused has been

extended the privilege of bail in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 16543 of 2016 vide order dated 26.04.2016.

In view of the facts and circumstances, similarly situated co-accused has been extended the privilege of bail in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 16543 of 2016 vide order dated 26.04.2016, let the petitioner, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the each amount to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st class, Aurangabad in connection with Goh P.S. Case No. 176 of 2015.
