According to the petitioner, there has been bungling in
the counting process and thus he also prays for an enquiry on the
complaint.

That the election has already been held and results
declared, the remedy for the petitioner for the grievance raised
would lie before the forum so provided under the Bihar Panchayat
Raj Act and the Election Rules framed thereunder. No cause for

indulgence is made out under Article 227 of the Constitution of India. The petitioner, if so advised, can take recourse to the statutory remedy available to him in law.

The writ petition is disposed of.
