The some essence of the prayer made in the writ application is to take over of the institution set up by a private individual.

Such schools are not required to be taken over by the State as there is neither a policy in place nor any law has been brought into effect to take over any institution or schools of such kind.

So far as aid and assistance from the government is concerned, this also is regulated and guided by the policy in vogue. Let the petitioner claim or assert his right which will be considered in accordance with law. No mandamus can be issued in favour of the

petitioner.

Writ is dismissed.
