2. This Civil Review Application has been filed on behalf of the Defendants-petitioners against the order dated 16.10.2014 passed by this Court in C.W.J.C. No.12512 of 2012, dismissing the aforesaid writ application, filed on behalf of the defendants-petitioners, under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, against the order dated 03.04.2012 passed in Title Eviction Suit No.107 of 2009, whereby the Sub-Judge, Begusarai, allowed the application filed on behalf of the Plaintiff-Respondent (opposite party) under Section 15

of the Bihar Building (Lease, Rent and Eviction) Control Act, 1982, with a direction to the defendant no.1 and defendant no.2 (petitioners), respectively, to deposit the arrears of rent @ Rs.4500/- and Rs.3500/- within fifteen days in the Civil Court Nazarat, Begusarai, with a further direction to deposit the current rent also by the 15th day of each month there.

3. I find no reason to review the order dated 16.10.2014 passed in C.W.J.C. No.12512 of 2012 by this Court.

4. Accordingly, this Civil Review Application is dismissed.
