petitioners seeks leave to withdraw this application to surrender

withdrawn.

However, if the petitioners surrender and seek
regular bail then the court below would proceed to take a decision
on its own merit and in accordance with law also considering the

issue that later on Sections 354, 406 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code under which the F.I.R. was lodged, charge-sheet was not submitted under those sections so far the petitioners are concerned, and, if possible, decision should be taken on the date of surrender itself.
