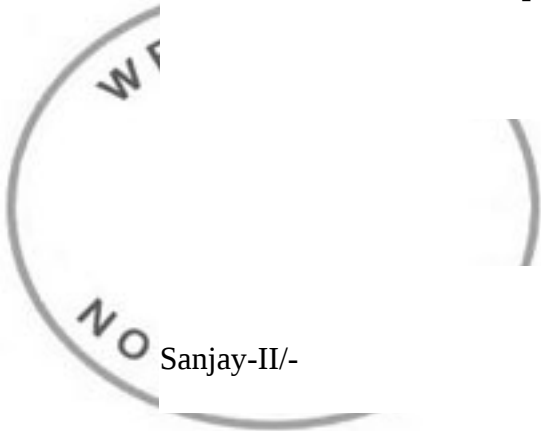
ORAL JUDGMENT
