2. Perused the impugned order dated 30.08.2016 passed by the A.D.J.-I, Danapur in Probate Case No. 39 of 2001, whereby the learned court below has allowed the application under Order 1 Rule 10 (2) C.P.C. filed by the respondent Nos. 2 and 3.

3. From perusal of the impugned order, it appears that the court below found that the interveners are claiming interest in the property, which is involved in the *Will* sought to be probated on the basis of purchase.
