In this case, the petitioner is seeking bail in connection
with Sessions Trial No.212 of 2011 / 177 of 2012, arising out of
Tandwa P.S. Case No.33 of 2010, registered for the offences
under Sections 302, 307, 120(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code and
under Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Perused the report of the Presiding Officer of the Court

It appears that before the Trial Court altogether 13
witnesses have been examined. In such view of the matter, there is
