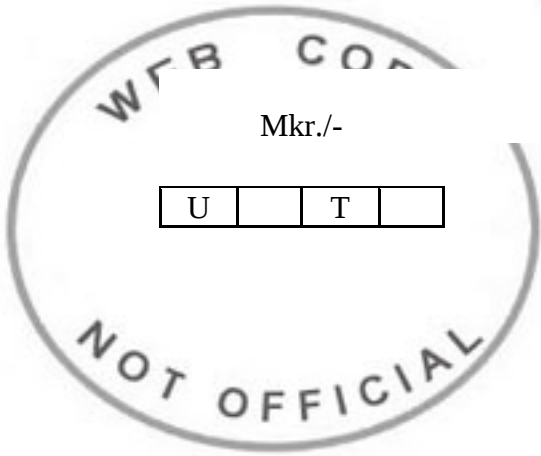
**CORAM: HONOURABLE THE CHIEF JUSTICE**
