Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 354B of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution case is that petitioner being tenant in the same building wherein the informant is also a tenant opened the paint of eight years old daughter of the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that from the FIR itself it appears that the informant is not an eye witness to the occurrence and since there was some petty dispute between the family members of the informant and the petitioner, the accusation has been levelled. A statement has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioner has

no criminal antecedent.

Considering the totality of the nature of accusation, it is a case for consideration of prayer for regular bail.

Let the learned Court below consider the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner, if the petitioner surrenders within a period of six weeks in connection with Mahesh Khunt P.S. Case No.119/2015, pending before the learned CJM, Khagaria.

With the above observation, this application is, accordingly, disposed off.
