2 19-01-2016 Heard Sri Ashok Kumar Sinha, learned counsel, who

was assisted by Sri Sudhir Kumar Sinha, learned counsel for the

petitioner and Sri Amrendra Prasad, learned A.P.P.

The petitioner, who is in custody in connection with

Amas P.S. Case No. 101 of 2013 registered for offence

punishable under Section 302, 120B of the Indian Penal Code

and Section 27 of the Arms Act, has prayed for grant of bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the

petitioner has falsely been implicated and he is lying in custody

since 14.5.2015 whereas, the learned A.P.P. opposing the prayer

of bail submits that the petitioner is the main assailant and

besides this, on perusal of paragraph no. 3 of the petition it is

evident that petitioner is a habitual offender and accused in

number of cases of serious nature.

Keeping in view the antecedent of the petitioner as well as the fact that petitioner is one of the main assailant, there is no need to grant bail to the petitioner.

The petition stands dismissed.
