Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
counsel for the State.

By way of the present application preferred under
Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners seek
quashing of the order dated 19th May, 2015 passed by the learned
Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Begusarai in connection with Complaint
Case No. 1815(C) of 2013, whereby the petitioners have been
summoned to face trial after taking cognizance of the offences
punishable under Sections 323 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.
