learned Counsel, appearing on behalf of the State-respondents.

After some argument, learned Counsel for the
petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this application with
liberty to take recourse to such provisions of law as may be
permissible.

While, accordingly, allowing the writ petition, as
sought for, to be withdrawn, we give the petitioner liberty to
lodge, if so advised, a *First Information Report* with
jurisdictional police station or file a complaint in the criminal
court of competent jurisdiction.

If a *First Information Report* is lodged or the
complaint is filed, the same shall be dealt with expeditiously and
in accordance with law.

With the above observation, this writ petition
stands disposed of.
