No doubt, petitioner sustained firearm injury in the alleged
occurrence and according to the prosecution case itself, one police
official, who happens to be body guard of a political person, opened
fire on the petitioner on the date of alleged occurrence but taking note
of the facts and circumstances as well as criminal antecedent of the
petitioner, I am not inclined to release him on bail and accordingly, his
prayer for bail in connection with Ujiyarpur P.S. Case no. 87/2014
corresponding to Sessions Trial no. 404/2014 pending in the court of
Addl. Sessions Judge, Dalsingsarai District Samastipur/concerned
court stands rejected.

However, the learned trial court is directed to expedite the

trial of the petitioner and try to conclude the same as early as possible.
