Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 384,
420, 120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that petitioner being husband of
the Panchayat Ward member, in collusion with Panchayat
Rojgar Sewak took the job card from several labourers and did
not pay their wages under the MANREGA scheme in 2013-14.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that petitioner is neither panchayat representative
nor he is member of the administration. The petitioner himself
is job card holder and maliciously he has been roped in the
present case.

A statement has been made in para 3 of the
petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the

petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Birpur, Supaul in connection with Raghopur P.S. Case No. 34 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
